“Biblically, holiness carries with it the common ancient idea of separateness, difference, not the same, other than!”

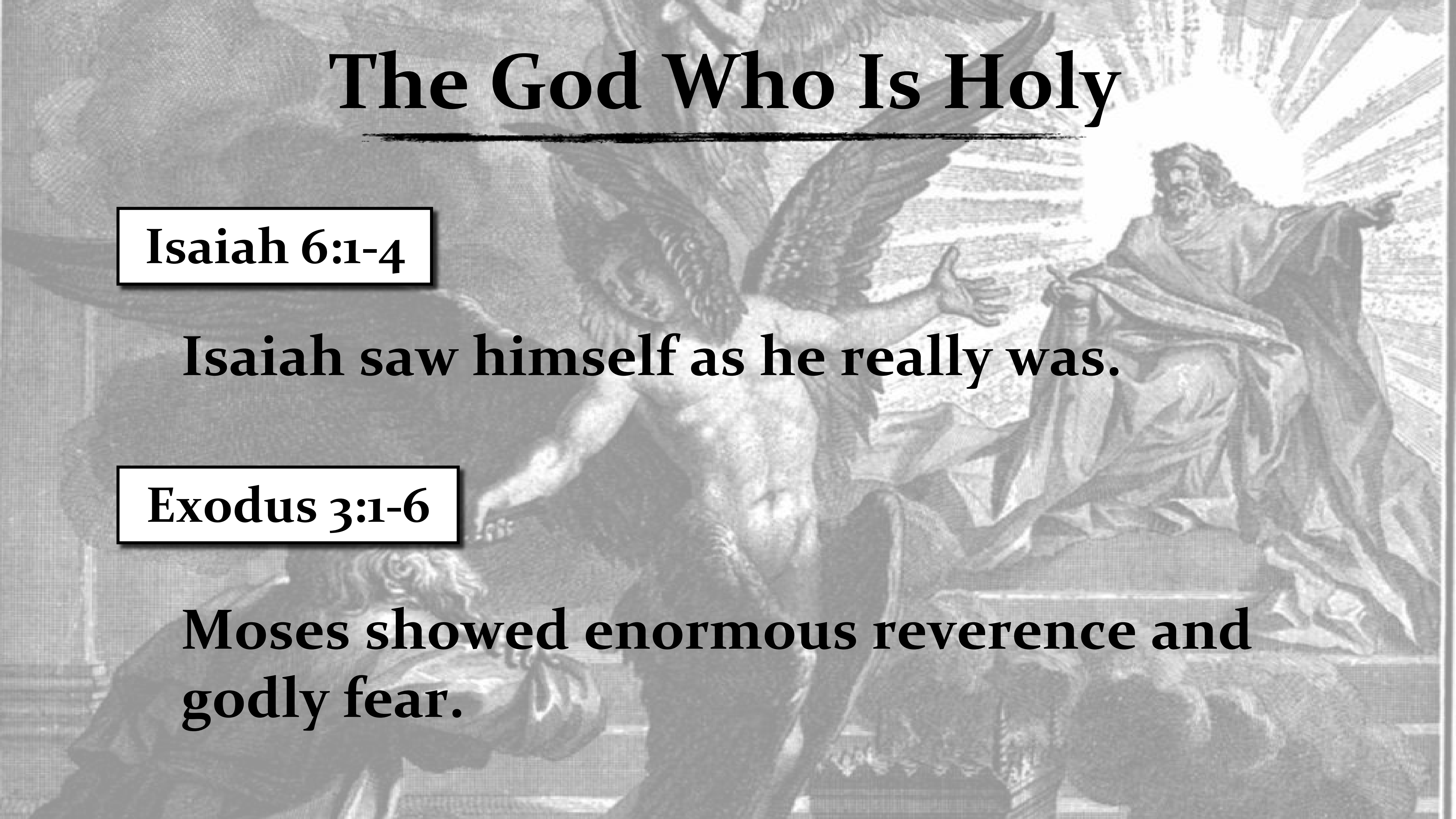

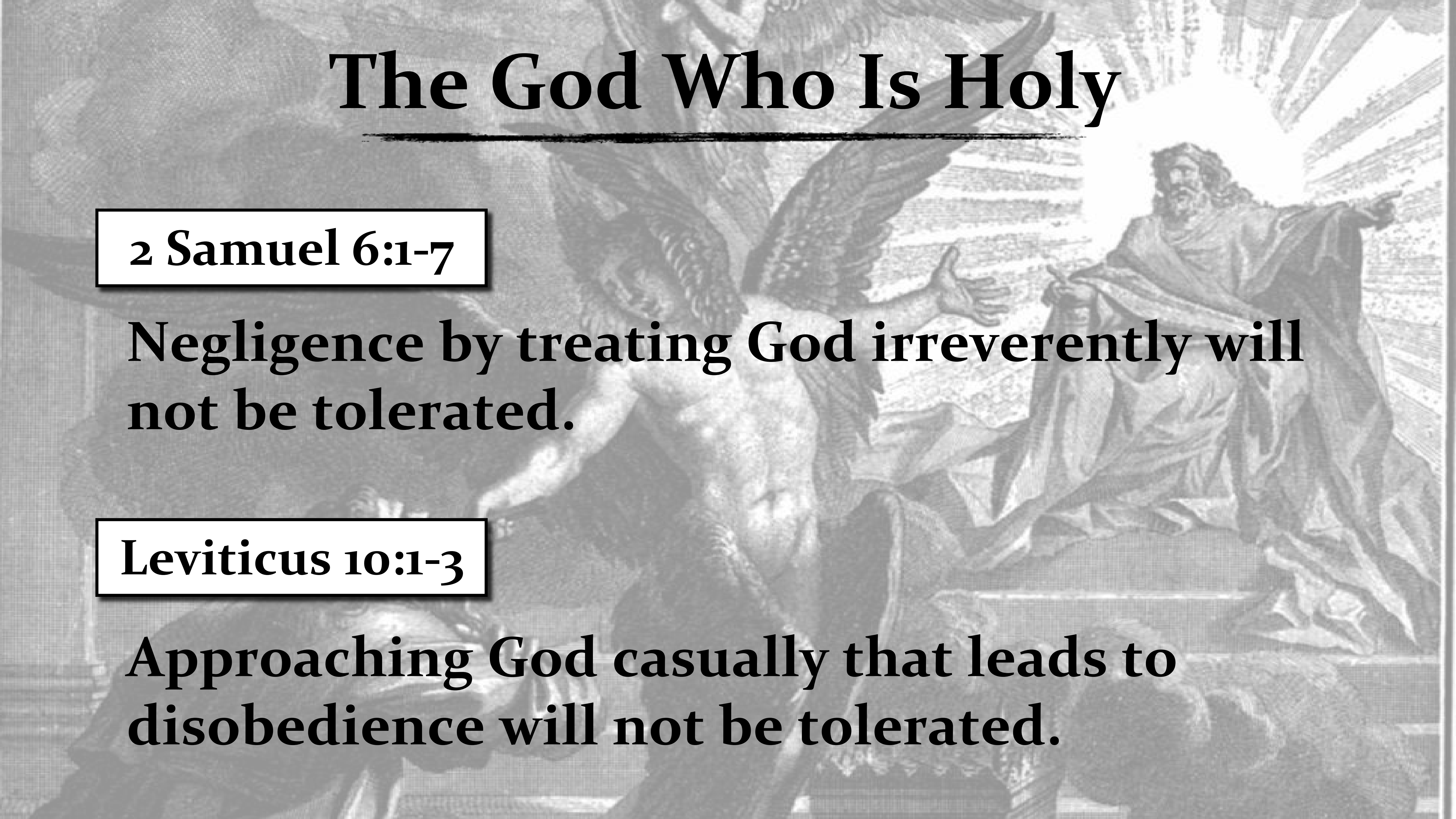

Negligence by treating God irreverently will not be tolerated.

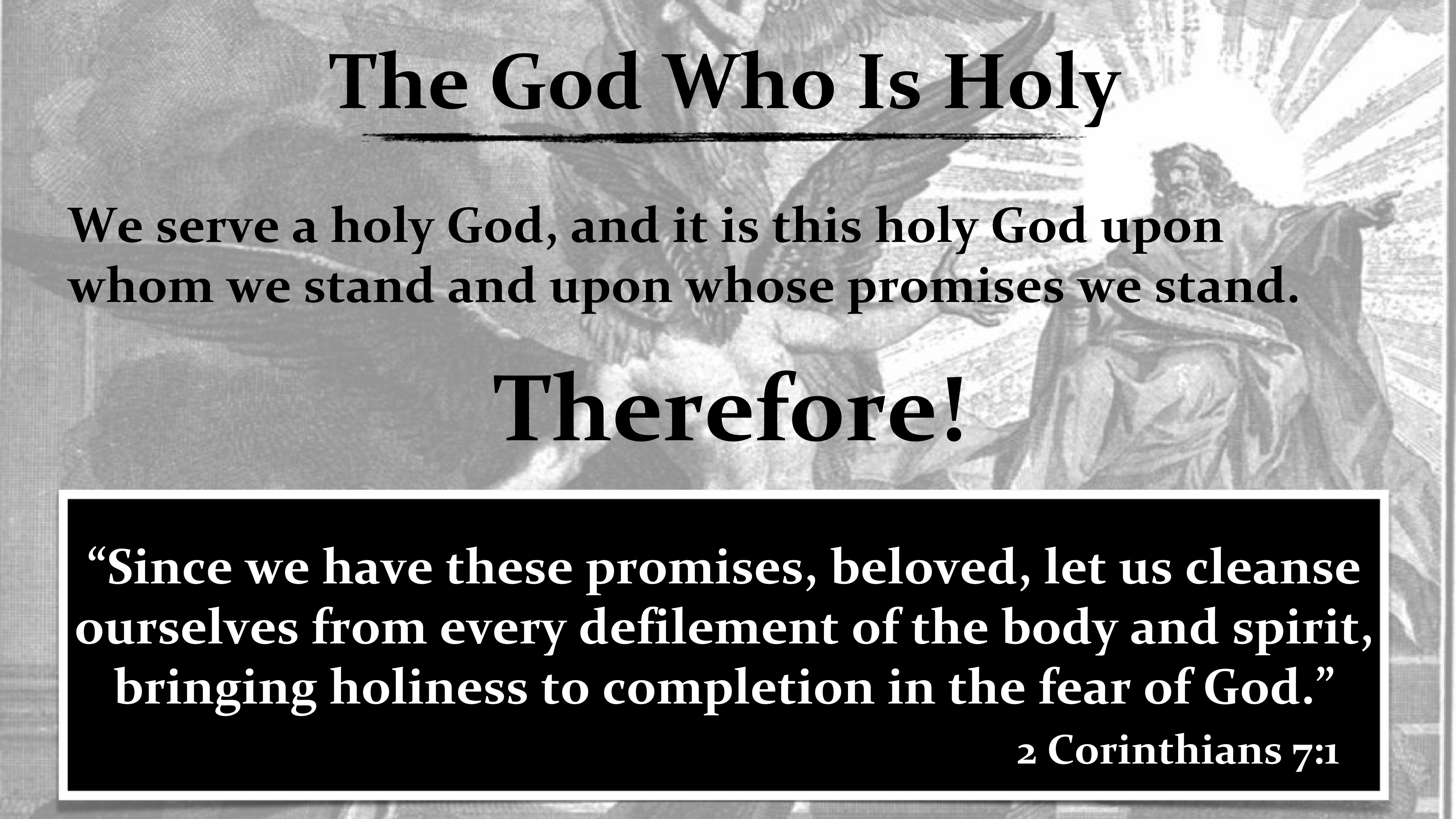
Leviticus 10:1-3
